- Estructuras:
 - Si se pregunta por algo que NO es el sujeto [es mucho más habitual]:
(Wh) + Aux + S + V + (Oi) + (Od) + (A) + (A) + ?
 - Si se pregunta por el sujeto:
(Wh) + V + (Oi) + (Od) + (A) + (A) + ? [la misma que en una afirmativa/negativa normal]
