     (Wh) + V + (Oi) + (Od) + (A) + (A) + ? [la misma que en una afirmativa/negativa normal]

- 8. They left all those heavy crates in the cellar.
  Where did the leave all those heavy crates?

9. I've been waiting for you here <u>for two hours!</u>
How long have you been waiting for us here?
