



Traduce y pasa a PASIVA (o a ACTIVA)

Utilizamos la **pasiva en Inglés** cuando utilizamos una **pasiva refleja en Español**. Ejemplo:



Acuérdate de los **pasos** para transformar de Activa a Pasiva:

- 1) Análisis Sintáctico
- 2) El Objeto de la activa pasa a ser el Sujeto de la pasiva
- 3) Transformamos el verbo:
["be" en el tiempo de arriba + participio del verbo de arriba]
- 4) El Sujeto de la activa pasa a ser el Complemento Agente de la pasiva, precedido de **"by"**
(opcional: si es un pronombre, lo pónlo entre paréntesis)
