


## SOLUCIÓN

### PHRASAL VERB: TAKE

Un verbo frasal es un verbo que cambia de significado según la partícula que lleva detrás.



Translate [ENGLISH→SPANISH]:

1. She has taken away the backpack. → (Ella) se ha llevado la mochila.
2. They haven't taken over. → No han tomado el control.
3. I've taken up kayaking. → He empezado a hacer kayak/remo.
4. Did you take it back? → ¿Lo devolviste/retomaste?
5. He takes care of his sister. → (Él) cuida de su hermana.
6. They take after their parents. → (Ell@s) se parecen a sus padres.
7. Will they take you on? → ¿Te contratarán (ell@s)?
8. I hadn't taken your pizza. → (Yo) no había cogido tu pizza.
9. The plane is taking off. → El avión está despegando.
10. I would take care of you all day. → (Yo) cuidaría de ti todo el día.

Translate [SPANISH→ENGLISH]:

11. El avión ha despegado. → The plane has taken off.
12. No te pareces a tu padre. → You don't take after your father/dad.
13. Han tomado el control. → They have taken control.
14. Cogeré la mochila. → I will take the backpack/(school)bag.
15. Lo he devuelto. → I have taken it back.
16. Contrataron a David. → They took on David.
17. ¿Los han devuelto? → Have they taken them back?
18. Me llevaría la pizza. → I would take away the pizza. / I would take the pizza away.
19. Se parece a su madre. → He/She/It takes after his/her/its mother/mom.
20. Están empezando a hacer surf. → They are taking up surf(ing).
